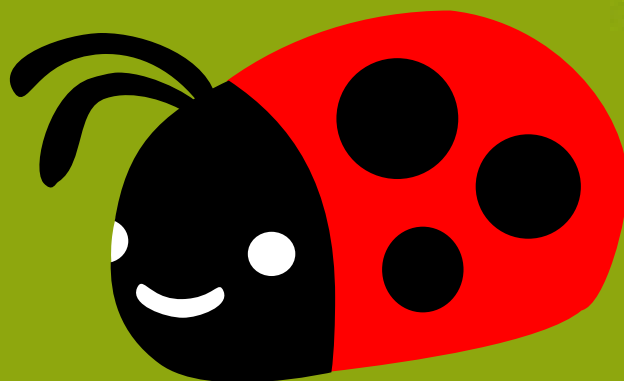
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Welcome

Here at Ladybirds we understand that choosing the right setting for your child is a big decision. We have been a part of the Horley community for over 20 years and have a fantastic team who will make sure every child feels safe, secure and loved.

Langshott Ladybirds is committee run and caters for a maximum of 21 children a session, aged from 2 to 5 years. We have a policy of inclusion and welcome children from all backgrounds, cultures, religions and those with specific needs.



Our sessions



- **Sessions are term time**
- **Monday-Friday AM 8:30-11:30**
- **Monday-Friday PM 11:30-2:30**
- **Monday-Friday full day 8:30-2:30**
- **Funded hours will be available from 8:30-2:30 daily with the option to increase this by 30 minutes to 3:00 at a cost of £4 a session.**
- **If your child does an afternoon session or full day, you will need to provide them with a packed lunch.**
- **We provide the Free Early Education to 3 and 4 year olds and the Free Early Education to 2 year olds (FEET)**
- **We also provide +15 (30) hours funded for those who are eligible and accept childcare vouchers**

The nursery environment

Our room

We have one room for all age groups, the older children gain confidence when helping their younger peers and our 2 year olds benefit from copying their older friends.

Everything in our room is tailored to the children's needs and is easily accessible to them.



The outside

At Ladybirds we offer a free flow system to our outside area, which is partially covered, and this is used in all weathers! We also have a garden area which is used regularly for gardening, mud kitchen play and climbing. Outdoor play is a big part of nursery life at Ladybirds and encourages seasonal learning and development.

Learning through play

At Ladybirds we give your child the opportunity to learn and develop through play. Activities are aimed at extending their joy, fascination, commitment and deep involvement, fostering their curiosity and confidence. Your child will have the opportunity to explore the real and imaginary world and form positive relationships with adults and their peers.



We provide a high quality nursery curriculum following statutory guidance from The Early Years Foundation Stage, and support your child as they become independent learners, enabling them to enter school with a positive outlook and firm foundations for learning. Our activities cover a range of festivals and celebrations and focus on the children's interests and development needs.

Our staff

All of our staff at Ladybirds are first aid trained and have a certificate in food hygiene and safety.

Our close-knit team work together to ensure activities are planned throughout the day with purpose and your child is engaged. Your child will be allocated their own key person, who will complete your child's record file and progress summaries. They will liaise with you regarding your child's development and well being and are there to support the settling in period.

As we are a small nursery all members of staff work closely with all the children in the setting.

All of the team have a wealth of knowledge and experience between them and keep up to date with all relevant training.

Frequently asked questions

- **Is there a uniform?** No, we recommend wearing comfortable, practical clothes which you don't mind getting dirty! Shoes need to be practical for climbing and running around in, so no open toed/heeled shoes. We do offer Ladybird jumpers and t-shirts, which are available to order.
- **Does my child need to be toilet trained?** No, we understand that children develop at different speeds and we will work with you when your child is ready. You will need to provide spare nappies, wipes and a change of clothes.
- **Does my child need to bring a packed lunch?** If your child does an afternoon session or a full day they will need to bring a healthy packed lunch with them. All children bring a fresh piece of fruit to share at snack time.
- **Do children doing a full day have a nap?** We don't nap the children, but there is a quiet area where they can rest and relax.
- **Do I need to contact nursery if my child is not attending due to illness or for holiday?** Yes, please let us know in advance with holidays and on the first day of absence for sickness.
- **Do I still have to pay fees if my child is off sick or on holiday?** Yes, fees are payable in full.
