Payment and notice

Langshott Ladybirds Nursery is a non-profit making committee run nursery, fees charged to parents and the free entitlement from the government form the total of our income.

Fees for the current year are £7.80 per hour with the option of an additional ½ hours charged at £4 per ½ hour

Method of payment: Payment is due on the first day of term, paid termly or half termly by cash or cheque (payable to Langshott Ladybirds Nursery).

Weekly payments are only accepted by agreements with the nursery manager. Fees overdue by more than two weeks will have a 10% surcharge levied to cover administration costs.

Universal Free Entitlement: Following the term after the child's third birthday they will receive up to 15 hours of free entitlement to nursery education. Forms for claiming the free entitlement will be supplied to parents by the nursery.

30 Hour Free Working ParentEntitlement: Funding for children the term after their second birthday (we are only registered for children over 2 yrs) is available to parents who meet the criteria set out by the local authority. Parents are responsible for obtaining their eligibility code and forwarding this to the nursery prior to booking the sessions.

FEET: Funding for children the term after their second birthday is available to parents who meet the criteria set out by the local authority. Parents are responsible for obtaining their confirmation of FEET funding in writing from the local authority, this must be presented to the nursery on application for sessions.

Holidays: Full fees are payable if holiday is taken during term time. A form to notify nursery of a parent taking a child out of nursery for a family holiday are available in nursery.

Sickness: Full fees are payable if a child is ill, in instances of prolonged, serious illness the management committee will consider each case individually. The local authority will be contacted in instances of funded places and their decisions applied. Absence of a child should be notified to the nursery by the parent on the first day of absence.

Notice: The period of notice is one term in writing or one term's fees in lieu of notice. If the child's place is funded then funding will be released back to the local authority in line with their current guidelines. Local authority funding is for whole weeks.
